We are writing back to you with some further details regarding the program.

We plan to structure the program around the challenges faced by judicial training institutes when confronting a variety of key issues:

- Artificial Intelligence (Monday, November 9)
- Cross-Border and Organized Crime (Tuesday, November 10)
- The Rule of Law, Ethics, and Professional Conduct (Wednesday, November 11)
- International Cooperation in Judicial Training (Thursday, November 12)

The program will consist of a plenary session (90 minutes) for each theme -except from Thursday-, followed by several simultaneous workshops (90 minutes).

As we explained in our previous emails, all ESFAME's proposal are very interesting, particularly insightful and well-supported, but we have to make choices to ensure that every institute and country is harmoniously represented.

We would like to invite, from your institute :

- **One or two speakers on Tuesday 10, to address the various themes of the proposal “Preparing Judges for Complex Criminal Threats: Building Institutional Capacity Against Organised Crime, Financial Networks and Digital Threats”.**
Would you be disposed to speak during the plenary session? We believe you have important, valuable insights to share with a wider audience.
- **One or two speakers on Wednesday 11, to join a workshop about “Training judges in institutional communication” and speak on the themes outlined in the proposal “Strengthening professional integrity, social awareness and public communication skills among judges”.**

The discussions could be led by a moderator (TBD), and we will follow up with you at a later date to specify your speaking time and any particular angles to focus on, ensuring the workshop runs seamlessly.

We would be grateful if you could confirm by June 22 whether this approach meets with your approval.

Our previous email wasn't clear; please accept our apologies.

As for the programme, we are planning to organise themed days focusing on issues relating to judicial training in the context of AI and digital technology (1), transnational crime (2), the rule of law and ethics (3), and the importance of exchanges between schools (4). This is why we cannot really envisage merging the content of your two proposals.

Our suggestion was to choose “Strengthening professional integrity, social awareness and public communication skills among judges” and to include it in a workshop with other speakers, focusing on the theme ‘Training judges in institutional communication’. This topic is very interesting, and we have fewer proposals for it than for others (such as AI, for example).

About the second topic, we're thinking more along the lines of themed days: AI for one day, transnational crime for another day. Would you be interested in joining the plenary about "Transnational and complex crime : a challenge for judicial training institutions", with you presentation : "Preparing Judges for Complex Criminal Threats: Building Institutional Capacity Against Organised Crime, Financial Networks and Digital Threats"?

Would it be convenient for you to choose these two topics?

We could have one or maximum two speakers per panel from your school, since we received a lot of proposals and we have to organise a well-balanced program.

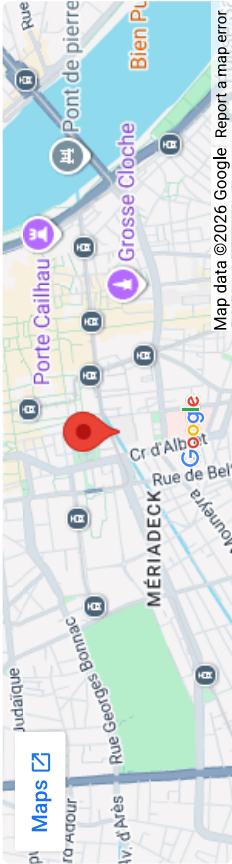

How to get to the conference ?

The event will primarily take place at the **École nationale de la magistrature (ENM)**, located at 10 rue des Frères Bonie, 33000 Bordeaux.

From **Bordeaux Saint-Jean Train Station**

- **By Tram (Recommended):**

- Option 1: Take **Line F** (direction Arsac / Gare de Blanquefort) and get off at the **"Palais de Justice"** stop. This is a direct 15-minute journey that drops you right at the school's entrance.
- Option 2 : Take Line C (direction Parc des Expos) or Line D (direction Cantinolle). Get off at "Porte de Bourgogne," then transfer to Line A (direction Mérignac Soleil) and get off at **"Palais de Justice"**.
- **By Taxi:** Approximately 15 to 20 minutes depending on traffic.

From Bordeaux-Mérignac Airport (BOD)

- **By Tram: Line A** directly connects the airport to the city center. Get off at the **"Palais de Justice"** stop. The journey takes about 35 minutes.
- **By Shuttle (Bus 30'Direct):** This shuttle connects the airport to the Saint-Jean train station in 30 minutes without intermediate stops.
- **By Taxi:** Approximately 30 to 45 minutes depending on the time of day.

Accessibility: The **"Palais de Justice"** tram stop (Line A) is located less than a 2-minute walk from the school's main entrance.

Taxis and Private Transport To facilitate your travel from the airport or the station, here are the main taxi services in Bordeaux:
